Then he found a long "oval" (place on top of the bottom of the hat as a brim)

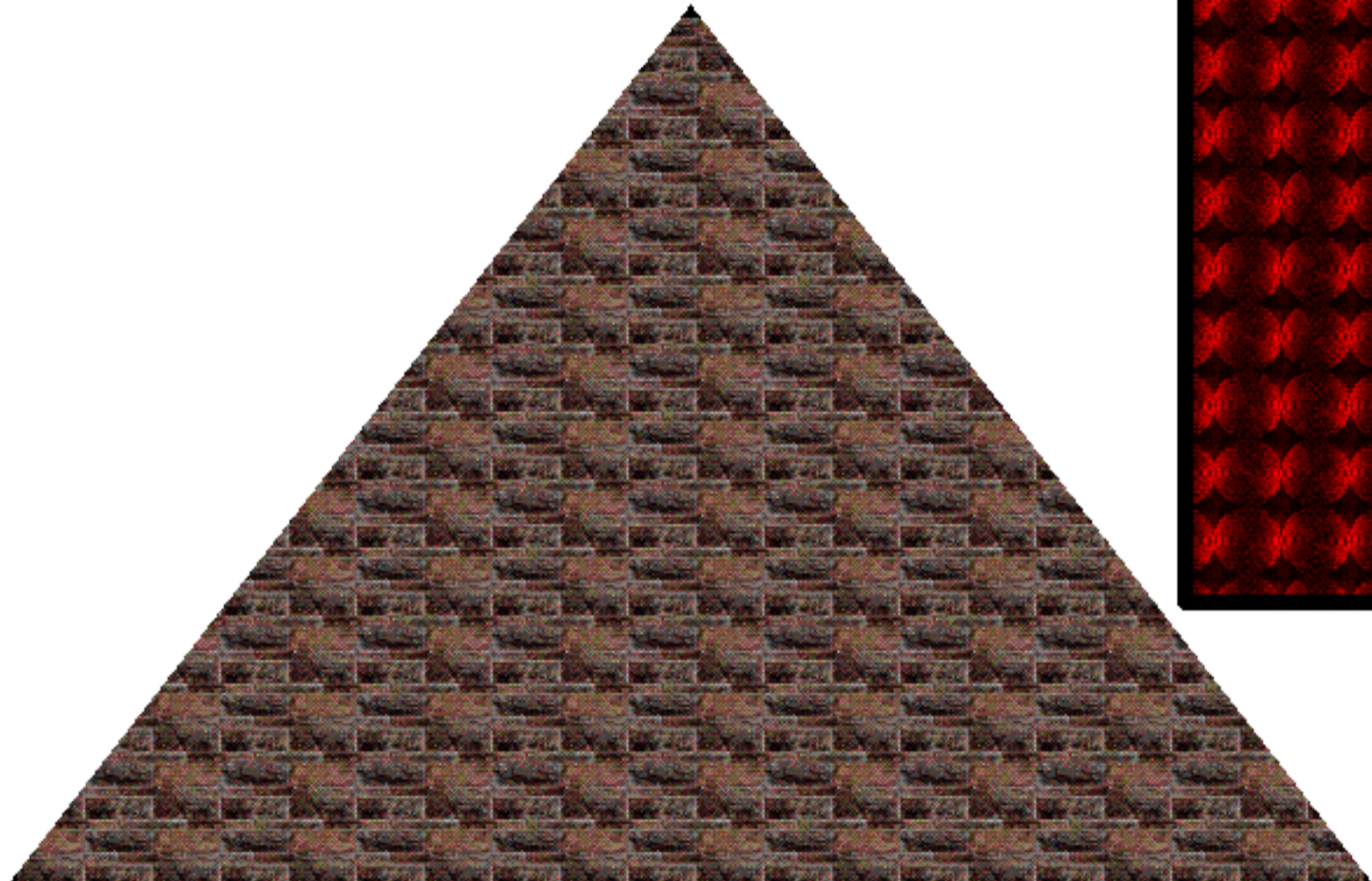
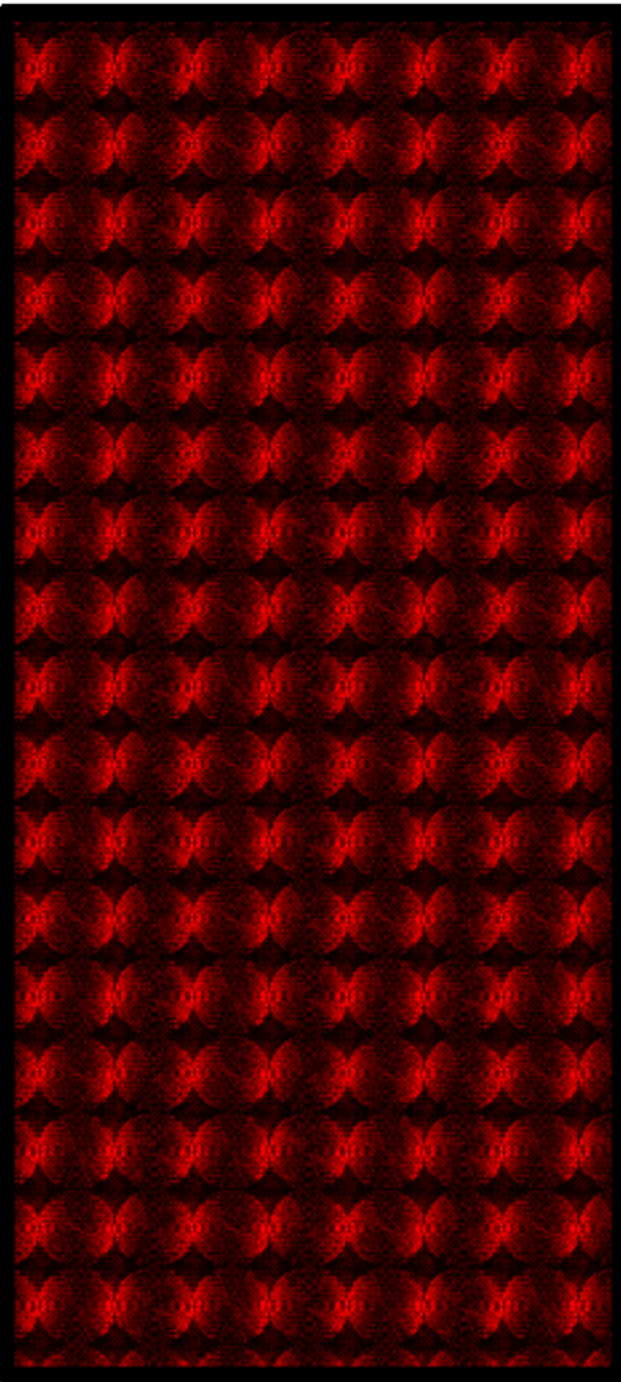
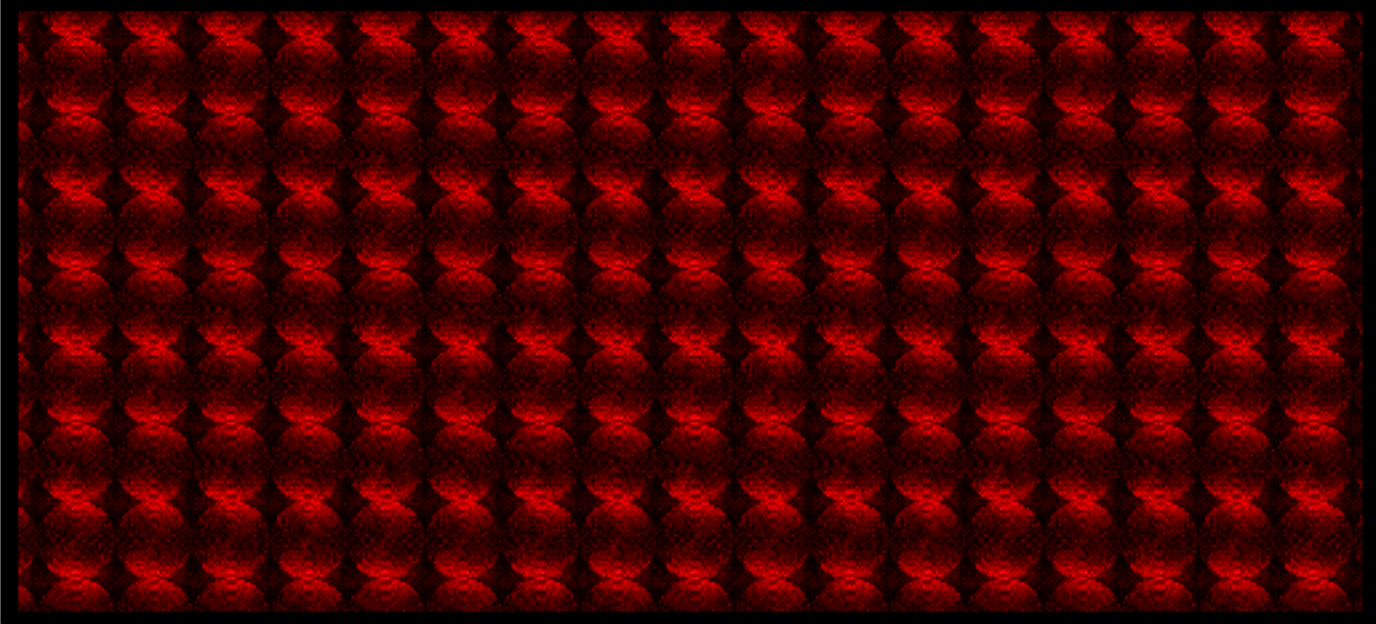
Then he looked up at what he had made with all the pieces and he was very surprised. It looked a bit like him.
